

WHAT GOES INTO TEAM SALARY?







(CBA Article VII, Section 4) Note: there is modified Team Salary calculations for Luxury Tax and Apron purposes)

Team Salary: What Counts Against the Cap

- Base Salaries from active contracts (including "Likely" bonuses)
- Salaries remaining from waived and retired players (could be "stretched")
- Other contracts and inclusions (ex: 10-day contracts)
- "Cap Holds" (placeholders for a team's rights)







Base Salaries & Bonuses

- "Regular Salary" means the player's salary without signing bonuses or incentive compensation
 - Can never be below the Minimum or Maximum allowed via the CBA
- Maximum Salaries: based on Years of Service (YOS) in the NBA
 - 0-6 YOS: 25% of the Cap at signing or 105% of player's prior season salary
 - **7-9 YOS: 30%** of the Cap at signing or 105% of player's prior season salary
 - >10 YOS: 35% of the Cap at signing or 105% of player's prior season salary
- Bonuses
 - **Performance** (total limited to 20% of player's Regular Salary for the given Salary Cap Year)
 - Likely (based on specific benchmarks achieved in the season prior)
 - Unlikely (limited to 15% and the team must have Room for salary + incentives)
 - Signing (limited to 15% of total compensation excluding incentives)
 - Trade (limited to 15% of total compensation remaining on the player's contract when traded)





Salaries from Waived & Retired Players

- Roster spot opens when waiver of a player is requested (generally irrevocable)
- Player is entitled to any guaranteed salary the team still owes
- Teams have the option to stretch the player's remaining guaranteed salary if it is over \$500k
 - Waived In-Season (September 1-June 30): pay the current season normally and stretch the remaining aggregated salary over 2x+1 outlined below
 - Waived Offseason (July 1-August 31): team can stretch a player's remaining salary by 2x the amount of years remaining on the deal plus an additional year
- Ex: Mavs waived JaVale McGee in August with \$11.7M owed to him over 2 seasons
 - \circ \$11.7/[(2)x(2)+1] = \$2.34M stretched over the next 5 seasons







Cap Holds (brief overview)

- Free Agent Amounts: placeholder for player's expected new salary that remains until player:
 - \circ 1) Signs his contract (re-signs or signs with new team); or
 - 2) Team renounces the player (including any Bird rights associated)
- Salary Cap Exceptions Including: Mid-Level, Bi-Annual, Trade, and Disabled Player Exceptions
 - Excludes: 2nd Round Pick Exception, and teams can renounce their rights to an exception
- Unsigned 1st Round Picks: 120% of the designated rookie salary for the player drafted
 - Ex: rookie scale for 2nd OVR pick Brandon Miller was 120% of rookie scale amt \$9.067M
- Amounts for incomplete roster (less than 12 players)
 - Placeholders for each spot equivalent to the min salary for a rookie for that cap year
- Outstanding Offer Sheets: contracts the player's previous team has the right to match
 - Ex: Portland matched the Mavs offer sheet for Matisse Thybulle summer of '23





Other Contracts and Inclusions

- **10-Day Contracts** completed during the Salary Cap Year
- Grievances between player and team over Player's Contract [Section 4 (iii)(A-D), (iv)]
- Amounts the Minimum Team Salary (MTS)
 - MTS is the lower of 90% of the Salary Cap for that year & the Team's MTS Cap Hold Team
 Salary at the start of the Regular Season [Article VII, Section 2(c)(3)]
 - A Team below MTS must:
 - 1) pay the difference between its Team Salary and MTS
 - 2) distribute that payment to players on the roster that season
 - 3) not receive any share of the tax distribution for non-taxpaying teams
