JUMPSHOT/PLAYSTYLE HAS SUCH A HIGH UPSIDE IN A 3-POINT-DOMINATED LEAGUE THAT IT MAY BE WORTH TAKING HIM EARLIER THAN PROJECTED (ESPECIALLY IF THE TEAM IS KNOWN FOR PLAYER DEVELOPMENT).



BEN SHEPPARD

SHEPPARD WOULD BE A TERRIFIC FLOOR SPACING GUARD. NEEDS TO PUT ON SOME WEIGHT, BUT HE MOVES WELL WITHOUT THE BALL AND SHOOTS INCREDIBLY EFFICIENTLY WITH A SMOOTH, QUICK RELEASE.



TRAYCE JACKSON-DAVIS

TJD'S SHOOTING EFFICIENCY (OR LACK THEREOF) WOULD TYPICALLY SCARE ME OFF. HOWEVER, I THINK HIS OTHER SKILLS ARE SO APPEALING THAT HE MAY NOT EVEN NEED TO DEVELOP A JUMPSHOT OUTSIDE OF A MIDRANGE TO STILL PROVIDE GREAT VALUE AS A ROLE PLAYER.



KOBE BROWN

I LOVE BROWN FOR A PROJECTED 2RP. SURE HIS CEILING MIGHT NOT BE SUPER HIGH, AND THERE'S CONCERN ABOUT WHETHER HIS JUMP SHOT WILL TRANSLATE BECAUSE OF PRIOR INEFFICIENT SEASONS, BUT THE UPSIDE WOULD BE TREMENDOUS AND HE IS VERY DEVELOPED FOR AN INCOMING ROOKIE.
